Hi Bron Marie

I am undertaking the role of Chair of the Riverland Cluster Clinical Review Committee, and am wondering if it is possible to attend your next Division of General Practice meeting to discuss some of the clinical governance changes as well as other clinical services within the cluster and across CHSA.

As aware, we were requested last week to prepare a submission with less than a weeks turn around time for an Aged care Nurse practitioner role for the Riverland of which the Director of nursing at each of the 5 health units were to discuss with their local GP workforce to seek feedback for this submission.

I met individually with Grant Baker and Ken Wanguhu, to seek some in principle support as local GP's as well as their role with Div GP and RDWA respectively, and to discuss the suggested role that a Aged Care NP could potentially undertake within the Riverland, and sought support that the DON's could use them as referees as relevant to our project management experience in the submission, which we have included.

I also clarified with Grant some confusion in relation to the submission that I believe occurred in translation of my initial conversation with the practice manager, which led to some concern at the last Division of GP meeting, which I would be happy to discuss further with all.

This submission is currently with Belinda Moyes, CE CHSA, and finalising before being sent off.

A copy of the submission will be provided to all as soon as we receive this back from Belinda, and this will be discussed on an ongoing basis as part of the newly created Cluster Clinical Review Committee.

The newly created Cluster Clinical Review committee membership will include a GP from each of the 5 Riverland townships, and the health unit DON's have been liaising directly with the practices within their towns to advise who will be represented on this committee.

A copy of the TOR have been attached for your information.

The initial meeting of this group is currently scheduled for later this month. (Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June 0900 – 1100)
