CURRENT PROGRAMS INCLUDE:

Aged Care

RDGP assists GP's and residential aged care facilities as they work together to improve medical care for aged care residents.

Asthma

RDGP assists medical practices and specifically trained practice nurses to conduct asthma clinics.

Diabetes

RDGP assists GP's, general practices, the Riverland Diabetes Advisory Service Group and other health professionals provide the best possible care for patients.

Home Medicines Review (HMR)

RDGP assists with collaboration between GP's and community pharmacies as they assess patients' safe use of medication, particularly in their homes.

Immunisation

RDGP assists general practice clinics, child and youth health, local councils, hospitals and the community to increase immunisation awareness and take up rates.

Mental Health

RDGP assists GP's who are managing patients with mental health problems, by providing a range of free services which can help to improve the quality of care.

National Prescribing Service (NPS)

RDGP assists health professionals and patients with information about how to choose, use and manage medicines wisely.

Peelies Bus Project

RDGP assists GP's and health professionals to provide a mobile health service for the region's indigenous community.

Practice Nurses

RDGP assists practice nurses with education and professional development opportunities.
